Several girls in Year 6 have developed an itchy, raised red rash on their face and neck. They do not appear or feel unwell in any way, although the itchiness is a little uncomfortable. The RGSAO Health Administrator, Mrs Small, has visited Springfield to check the girls and is happy for them to remain in school. She suggests that the affected area is treated with an antihistamine/sting relief cream, such as Anthisan, or that they take a Piriton tablet. If you are at all concerned, or your daughter becomes unwell, please consult your doctor.
